

Millersville University has a very large incoming class that is in need of on-campus housing. Therefore, Housing and Residential Programs is experiencing a larger demand for on-campus housing than in previous years. To handle this overflow situation, we have created "triples". A triple is an overflow situation where we place three students in a standard double room.

Soon you will be receiving your housing assignments. Some of you have been assigned to a triple. We know that this may cause some anxiety, for us as well, but we ask that you reflect on the following:

- We anticipate receiving some housing cancellations on a daily basis starting today through the start of the school year. As we receive these cancellations, we will begin the "de-tripling" process.
- The quality of your housing experience is not related to the number of roommates, but rather related to the positive relationships you build with your roommates. Creating these relationships takes work from all involved and many times is rewarded by lasting friendships.
- The size of the room may create some concern, even before arriving to Millersville. Like students assigned to a double room, it is imperative that all roommates communicate before they arrive for Orientation.

Please understand that we are doing all we can to minimize the time students will be assigned to an overflow room. As we are able to remove students from this overflow situation, we will communicate this to you by phone call.
